How much does it cost?

- Charges based upon your income and family size. No one is refused service because of inability to pay
- All income levels and most insurance companies are accepted including Medical Assistance and MinnesotaCare
- We are a provider of the Minnesota Family Planning Program, also known as the MFPP or ONE Program



What is the MFPP?

• The MFPP is an insurance program through the state that covers the cost of family planning related services

Who is the MFPP for?

- Men and women between the ages of 15 and 50 who are not enrolled in Medical assistance, MinnesotaCare or General Assistance Medical Care
- What are the guidelines for the MFPP?
 - Are between 15 and 50 years of age
 - Minnesota resident
 - U.S. citizen (or non-citizen eligible to participate in federallyfunded programs)
 - Not pregnant
 - Not enrolled in Medical Assistance (MA), Minnesota Care, General Assistance Medical Care or another state-funded program
 - Earn no more than the weekly income limits depending on family size (i.e., \$416 for family of 1, \$560 for family of 2, \$704 for family of 3, \$848 for family of 4). If you are a student, your parents' income is not a factor in determining eligibility. Any assets such as a car or house do not count against you.
 - Private health insurance does not affect your eligibility.

How do I enroll?

- Bring proof of your income: pay-stubs within the last 30 days or a letter from your employer verifying weekly wages
- Bring proof of citizenship: copy of your birth certificate or passport AND a photo ID such as a driver's license or student photo ID. Immigration documents are accepted in place of a birth certificate
